Launched in 2011 with just four teams, the Pre-Moot currently attracts contestants from faculties from Afghanistan, Bahrain, Germany, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, Tunisia, the United Arab Emirates and other countries. 535 students have so far benefited from the support of around 350 mentoring arbitration practitioners, academics, and jurists.

I would like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation to all those who have supported BCDR, who have worked with us and who have generously given their time to contribute in the organization of this eventful week: our loyal staff, our partners, and our many friends and advisers.
